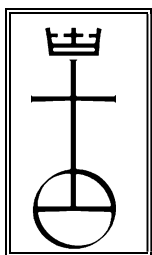


Zion Church Annual Congregational Meeting

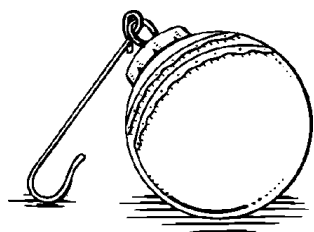
